Louise Baxter McMahan, of Chestertown, MD, passed away on Friday, May 25, 2018, at University of Maryland Shore Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in Chestertown. She was 94.

Born on August 8, 1923, in Queen Anne's County, MD, she was the daughter of the late J. Albert and Bertha Hunter Baxter. She graduated from Chestertown High School, Class of 1940. Mrs. McMahan worked with Verizon as a service representative for nearly 39 years, until she retired in 1983. She was a member of First United Methodist Church, the Homemakers Association, the Senior Golden Age Club, the Chester River Advocate for the Blind (C.R.A.B) and she was a life member of Telephone Pioneers. She enjoyed sewing, reading, and working in the yard.
