Mary Louise Remont Valliant died at her home, in Oxford, MD, on Friday October 6, 2006, after an extended illness. She was 92.

Born April 29, 1914, in Media, PA, she was the daughter of the late Anna Deans and Louis Maurice Remont. Mrs. Valliant was educated in the Delaware County Public Schools before attending Duke University, where she was a member of Zeta Tau Alpha sorority. One June 8, 1935, she married Jeremiah Valliant, who preceded her in death in 1994.

A member of the Church of the Holy Trinity in Oxford, Mrs. Valliant was an active member of the Altar Guild and the ECW. Prior to moving to Oxford in 1970, Mr. and Mrs. Valliant were active members of St. Peters Episcopal Church of Salisbury, MD; serving in various capacities, including president, of the ECW and the Alter Guild. She was also very active in the Junior Board Auxiliary of Peninsula General Hospital.
