



Louise Randolph Craig Anderson

Louise R. C. Anderson of Stevensville, MD, died on April 18, 2001, at Spa Creek Center in Annapolis after a lengthy illness. She was 85.

Born on January 10, 1916, in Augusta, GA, she was one of five children of the late Samuel Roland Craig and Sally Aiken Craig. She graduated from high school in Augusta and received her Registered Nursing Degree from St. Joseph's Hospital in Baltimore, MD. On June 14, 1937, she married William M. Anderson, Jr., of Baltimore, MD, and they resided in Pikesville, MD, before moving to Stevensville in May of 1960.

During her career, Mrs. Anderson worked as a registered nurse for Children's Rehabilitation Institute in Baltimore County, then for the Anne Arundel General Hospital from 1960 to 1977, where she worked in nearly all departments. She was instrumental in the opening of the new A3 and A4 wings at the hospital in the late 1960's. Mrs. Anderson was one of the original parishioners to establish St. Christopher's Roman Catholic Church in Chester, MD, and continued as a member of that parish until she began her stay at Spa Creek Center in January 2000. Her husband predeceased her on December 29, 1986.

Mrs. Anderson is survived by two sons, William M. Anderson, III of Annapolis and Robert C. Anderson of Darlington, MD; a brother, Richard Z. Craig, and a

sister, Celeste Griffin, both of Augusta, GA; three grandchildren, Eric Craig Anderson of Frederick, MD, Michelle Lynee Anderson of Annapolis, and Robert C. Anderson, Jr. of Baltimore; several step-grandchildren and step-great-grandchildren.

Services will be 11:00 am, Saturday April 21, at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Chester, MD, where family and friends may call one hour prior to the service. Burial will be at Woodlawn Memorial Park in Easton.
