



## Louise Walls Skinner

December 28, 1920 - June 30, 2017

Louise Walls Skinner of Centreville died Friday June 30, 2017, at her home. She was 96.

Born on December 28, 1920, in Barclay, MD, to the late W. Leonard Walls and Pearle Sparks Walls. She attended Sudlersville High School, graduating in Class of 1937. She then continued her education at Beacom College, graduating in 1939. Mrs. Skinner began working in Wilmington, DE, with the Discount and Credit Corporation. In 1941-42, she worked at the Queen Anne's Welfare Board.

On November 16, 1940, she married John W. Skinner and resided near Ingleside. Mrs. Skinner remained home caring for their family and assisting with the family farm. After the kids were all in school, she began working at the Sudlersville Bank and later retired from Social Services in 1991, with 25 years of service.

Mrs. Skinner was a member of the Ingleside and Queen Anne's County Homemakers Clubs, and a lifetime member of St. Paul's UMC in Ingleside.

Mrs. Skinner is survived by three sons, John W. "Jerry" Skinner, Jr. (Linda) of Lincoln, DE, Eugene L. Skinner (Gail) of Cambridge, MD, and Glenn A. Skinner of Lincoln, DE; daughter-in-law Suzanne Skinner of Ingleside, MD;

eleven grandchildren; and twenty-two great grandchildren. Her husband of 66 years predeceased her in 2007. She was also predeceased by a son, Donald W. Skinner; a daughter, Janet L. Skinner; and a sister, Pauline Thompson.

A funeral service will be at 12:00 pm on Thursday July 6, 2017, at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A. in Centreville, MD, where family and friends may visit starting at 11:00 am. Burial will follow the service in Church Hill Cemetery.
