Louise Valliant Willis, a life-long resident of Oxford, MD, died on Wednesday, October 23, 2002, at William Hill Health Care, in Easton. She was 101.

Born July 4, 1901, she was the daughter of the late Jeremiah and Susan Parsons Valliant. She was a 1918 graduate of Oxford High School. For over fifty years she owned and operated The Towne Shoppe at 300 N. Morris Street in Oxford. In 1941, she married Edward Willis. Mr. Willis died August 2, 1960.

A member of Church of The Holy Trinity in Oxford, she sang in the choir, taught Sunday School and held various other positions in the church. She was a life member of the Oxford Vol. Fire Company Ladies Auxiliary.

Mrs. Willis is survived by several nieces and nephews; and a sister, Harriett McCord. Two brothers, Robert T. Valliant, Sr., and Jeremiah Valliant are deceased.

A memorial service will be held on Monday, November 4, 2002, at 2:00 PM at Church of The Holy Trinity, Oxford, MD.
