Louis Henry "Parkie" Parkinson of Easton, MD died on Wednesday, January 3, 2007 at Genesis Health Care-The Pines, Easton. He was 85.

Born January 2, 1922 in Annapolis, MD, he was the son of the late Herman and Lena Whittington Parkinson. From 1942 to 1945 he served in the U.S. Army as a parachute maintenance technician.
