Louis L. Boldt of Easton, MD died at his home on Tuesday, March 25, 2008. He was 86.

Born March 20, 1922 in Bellwood, IL, he was the son of the late Louis A. and Minnie B. Vegter Boldt. After graduating from Proviso High School in Maywood, IL in 1940, he attended the Illinois Institute of Technology where he received a Bachelor of Science Degree in Engineering in 1943. From 1943 to 1946 he served in the U.S. Navy as a Civil Engineer with the rank of 1st Lieutenant. After release from active duty, he took a position as an engineer with the Universal Form Clamp Company in Chicago, transferring to Baltimore, MD in 1954. He then worked with the Symons Corporation from 1960 to 1964 when he left to begin his own company, Form Services, Inc., where he remained until his retirement in 2006.

He was a member of B.P.O. Easton Elks Lodge #1622.

Mr. Boldt is survived by his wife, the former Nancy Butler, whom he married April 6, 1975; his son, Larry Boldt and his wife Nancy; two step-sons, John Butler and his wife Carol, and Michael Butler and his friend Helen Wiggins; one sister, Arllowa Essig; a granddaughter, Kim Karoma and her husband Mo; three step-grandchildren, Michael Butler, Travis Butler, and Sheli Butler; six great-grandchildren; and many nieces and nephews. He was predeceased by

his brother-in-law, Herbert Essig.

A Funeral Liturgy for Mr. Boldt will be celebrated on Saturday, March 29, 2008 at 1:00 PM at the St. Michaels Mission Church, 109 Lincoln Ave., St. Michaels, MD 21663.
