Louis "Uncle Lou" Hooker of Easton, MD died at the home of his nephew on Saturday, June 7, 2008. He was 77.

Born June 22, 1930 in Baltimore, MD he was the son of the late Joseph and Margaret Kehoe Hooker. After attending school he began training and exercising race horses. From 1952 to 1954 he served in the U.S. Army. Upon his release from active duty he returned to training horses, traveling all over the region.
