



## Lowell Ray Shaw

March 20, 1942 - July 2, 2012

Lowell Ray Shaw of Chestertown, MD, died on July 2, 2012, at the Queen Anne's County Hospice House in Centreville, MD. He was 70.

He was born on March 20, 1942, in Buckhannon, WV, son of the late Guy R. and Opal Beale Shaw. He was a 1960 graduate of Clay-Battelle High School and earned a Bachelor of Science Degree from West Virginia University and a Master's Degree from George Washington University in Washington DC. In 1964, he worked as a counselor with the National Science Camp in West Virginia.

Mr. Shaw continued his career as a 4-H agent for a few years where he met and married Carol S. Douglas. He primarily worked in the Educational Field as a teacher, dean, counselor, and basketball coach before moving to Chestertown, MD. In Chestertown, Mr. Shaw served as a summer conference coordinator with Washington College, a 4-H agent, a rehabilitation specialist with Crossroads, and Women's Basketball coach with Chesapeake College which was the most enjoyable career move.

He was a member of First United Methodist Church in Chestertown, MD, and the West Virginia 4-H All Stars. He enjoyed coaching and watching basketball, football, and baseball as well as reading and writing. He authored several books.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by a son, Doug Shaw of Denver, CO, and two brothers, Charles N. Shaw of Burke, VA, and Lynn Shaw of Centreville, VA.

Services will be held on Monday, July 9, 2012, at 7 p.m. at First United Methodist Church where relatives and friends may call one hour prior (6-7 p.m).
