A Funeral Liturgy for Lt. Col. Jess W. Henley, U.S. Army ret. of McLean, VA, formerly of Severna Park, MD, will be celebrated at Fort Myer Chapel, Arlington National Cemetery on Thursday, July 1, 2004 at 2:45 PM. Mr. Henley died on June 5, 2004 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. He was 88.

Born September 26, 1915 in Seloca, AL, he was the son of the late John P. and Mattie Martin Henley. In 1935 he joined the U.S. Army. For four years during World War II, he served in the African and European Theaters. After the war, he was stationed at various military posts in Germany and the United States, including Fort Meade. Upon retirement from the Army in 1959, Mr. Henley worked for the Social Security Administration where he adjudicated disability cases until his retirement in 1981.

A member of St. John's Roman Catholic Church in McLean, VA, his interests included golfing, the Washington Redskins, horse racing and spending time with his family.

Mr. Henley is survived by his wife, the former Agnes Una Sugrue, whom he married October 18, 1944 at St. Theresa's in Belfast, Ireland; six sons, Gene Henley of Sandy Spring, MD, Brian Henley of Severna Park, MD, Michael Henley of Glen Burnie, MD, Joe Henley of McLean, VA, Bill Henley of Easton, MD, and John Henley of Annandale, VA; five daughters, Deirdre Ohler of

Parker, CO, Laura de Armond of Las Vegas, NE, Mary de Armond of Federalsburg, MD, Patti Fraiser of Vienna, VA, and Geraldine T. Drake of Fairfax, VA; a brother, Judge Joe Lee of Lexington, KY; a sister, Jean Risner of Fairfield Glade, TN; fourteen grandchildren; and four great-grandchildren.

Burial will be at Arlington National Cemetery, Arlington, VA.
