Lucien Girard of Royal Oak, MD, passed away on Wednesday, November 5, 2008, at Talbot Hospice House, Easton, after a long illness.

Born in Brooklyn, NY, he grew up on Long Island, where he began a lifelong interest in sailing and lacrosse. He attended Pennsylvania State University where he majored in mining education, and earned B.S. and M.S. degrees in that field. He played lacrosse and coached the freshman team.

As a mining engineer, he traveled widely. In 1998, he retired from his position as Managing Director of Teberebie Goldfields, LTD in Ghana, West Africa.
