



## Lucille E. Harrison

March 12, 1918 - January 10, 2011

Lucille E. Harrison of Easton died at Genesis Healthcare – The Pines on Monday, January 10, 2011, at the age of 92.

Born on March 12, 1918, in the village of Violetville, which later became part of Baltimore City. She was the daughter of the late John H. and Theresa Mielke Edelmann. After graduating from Western High School in Baltimore in 1935, she married James L. Harrison, Jr. in 1936, to whom she was wed for 52 years. They made their home in Baltimore, where she was an active member of Bethany Evangelical Lutheran Church. After moving to the Eastern Shore, she joined Grace Lutheran Church in 1957.

The family moved to their home, “The Edge of Solitude” in Thorneton, near Royal Oak, MD, in 1956. They moved to South Beechwood in Easton in 1985. She was a homemaker, nature lover, and bird watcher. Mrs. Harrison was a devoted mother and grandmother.

She is survived by her four children, Pamela L. Behrens of Easton, J. Lowery Harrison, III, of Indianapolis, IN, Nancy S. Harrison of Castro Valley, CA, and Terry S. Harrison of Bethesda, MD; nine grandchildren; eleven great-grandchildren; and one great great-grandchild. In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, James L. Harrison, Jr., who died in 1988; and her brother, John G. Edelmann, who died in 2008.

Funeral services will be held at 3:00 pm on Friday, January 14, 2011, at the Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A. in Easton, where friends may call one hour prior to the service.

Burial will follow at Woodlawn Memorial Park in Easton.
