



## Lucretia Mae Jester

April 18, 1937 - October 13, 2012

Lucretia Mae Jester of Greensboro, MD, died Saturday, October 13, 2012, at the Chester River Hospital Center in Chestertown, MD. She was 75.

Lucretia M. Jester was born April 18, 1937, in Easton, MD, the daughter of the late James Harrison Ross and Lottie Mae "Scott" Ross. Lucretia married Emino Colon "Jimmy" Collazo, and he died January 18, 1982. She later married the late Harper Lee Jester of Centreville, MD.
