Lucy M. Libardi died on September 15, 2014, at University of Maryland Shore Medical Center at Easton. She was 88 years old.

Born on December 13, 1925, in Brooklyn, NY, she was the daughter of the late Salvatore D'Andrea and Philomena Cardone D'Andrea.

Lucy married Pietro Libardi in 1944, and they lived in Brooklyn and Woodhaven, NY, before moving to Easton, MD, in 2005. Lucy was a loving wife and mother.
