Lucy Joiner Walls of Crumpton, Maryland died on Friday, April 22, 2005 at Chester River Manor in Chestertown, Maryland. She was 93.

Born in Crumpton, Maryland on October 11, 1911, she was the daughter of the late, Howard and Mabel Skaggs Joiner. She was educated in Crumpton School and later married LeRoy Edward Walls. They resided in Crumpton where she raised their daughter. During WWII, Mrs. Walls worked with the Defense Plant in Chestertown, Maryland. She and her husband later delivered mail for the U.S. Postal Service to local Post Offices in the surrounding counties. They also delivered newspapers for several years.

Mrs. Walls was a devoted member of Crumpton United Methodist Church where she often helped in the kitchen and was known for her crab cake recipe. She loved animals, people and the Chester River.

She was pre-deceased by her husband.

Mrs. Walls is survived by a daughter, Catherine Faye Walls Noble of Preston, Maryland; two grandchildren, L. Karen Guthrie of Preston, Maryland and Clinton Wyatt Guthrie of Preston, Maryland, along with nieces and nephews. Two brothers predeceased her, Earl Joiner and Ronald Joiner.

Graveside services will be held on Wednesday, April 27, 2005 at 11:00 a.m. at Crumpton Cemetery.
