February 8, 1921 - October 31, 2013

Luetta Hill Smith, 92, of Easton, MD, went home to be with the Lord on Thursday, October 31, 2013.

Mrs. Smith was born in Williamsport, PA, on February 8, 1921. She was the daughter of the late, Charles Hill and Grace Frey Hill. She graduated from Williamsport High School in 1939. She was employed as an administrator for twenty years with the State of Maryland, working for various agencies, until retiring from The Court of Special Appeals. In her later years, she had the privilege and pleasure of leading women's bible studies for several local churches.

She is survived by two children, Marie Smith Mills, and Russell R. Smith, Jr., and his wife, Nancy; five grandchildren; ten great-grandchildren; and seven great great-grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her husband, Russell R. Smith, who died in 1985; a daughter, Grace Elaine Smith Sanders, who died in 1971, and a son, Douglas I. Smith, who died in 2010.

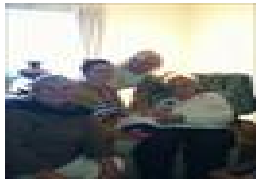
