



## Lula Mae Elliott

December 22, 1945 - April 22, 2025

Lula Mae Elliott, formerly of Trappe, MD, passed away on Tuesday, April 22, 2025 after a long hard-fought battle with cancer. She was 79 years old. She was born in Cambridge, MD on December 22, 1945 and was the daughter of the late Earl and Berlia Gunter.

Lula Mae attended school in Cambridge and graduated from Goldey-Beacom College in Wilmington, DE with a degree in Accounting. On February 24, 1967, she married Ernest Samuel "Sonny" Elliott, Jr. and they had three lovely daughters. For several years, Lula Mae drove the school bus for Countryside Christian School. She later became a Real Estate Broker and owned Shore Realty Associates in Easton, MD. She also was co-owner of L&L Title Abstract Services until she retired to the Dominican Republic.
