Lulu Virginia Wood, of Centreville formerly of Easton, died at the Meridian Nursing Center - Corsica Hills, Centreville, on Sunday, December 24, 2000. She was 97.

Born in Easton, September 30, 1903, she was the daughter of the late Calvin and Lulu Jones Anderson. After attending school at Tri-County School, she married George W. Dulin, a Talbot County farmer in 1921.
