



Luther W. Smith

July 24, 1925 - February 29, 2012

Luther W. "Luke" Smith, of Easton, MD, went to be with his Lord and Savior on February 29, 2012. He was 86.

Mr. Smith, born July 24, 1925, was the son of the late Floyd Roy and Ruth Edwards Smith. Educated in Dorchester County, Mr. Smith served in the U.S. Navy during WWII in the South Pacific. Following his honorable discharge, he worked for the Daily Banner and the Star Democrat as a pressman before starting his own business, Economy Printing Company, Inc., in 1947, where he remained until his retirement in 2005.

He was a member of Church of God in which he served faithfully as a member from 1950 until the time of his death.

Mr. Smith is survived by his second wife, Margaret Marshall Smith, whom he married on June 20, 1996; one son, Larry W. Smith (Janice) of Easton; five stepchildren, Josephine "Joedy" Cecil of Trappe, Julie Marshall of Federalsburg, Michael D. Marshall of Trappe, Edward P. Marshall of Baltimore and Lt. Cmd. Lynda S. LeCrone (David) of Centreville; two sisters, Gladys Murphy of Catonsville and Nancy Barrack (Joe) of Church Creek; two granddaughters, Amy E. Schwaninger (John) of Trappe and Andrea M. Smith of Easton; and three great-grandsons, John Melvin Schwaninger, IV, Daniel Jacob Schwaninger and Nathan Andrew Schwaninger. He is also survived by

three step-grandchildren, six step-great-grandchildren and many nieces and nephews.

Mr. Smith is predeceased by his first wife, Elizabeth Edna Burt Smith, who died March 16, 1996.
