Lyell Hale Ritchie of Chestertown, Maryland died on December 28, 2004 in Chester River Hospital Center. He was 77.

He was the son of the late Lyell Hale and Elspeth Wolff Ritchie. He graduated cum laude of Harvard University in 1950. After graduation, he served two years in the US Army as a cryptologist, stationed in Korea and Japan. During the course of his career as a financial analyst in international development, Lyell traveled and lived in many parts of the world including East Africa, Egypt, Malaysia, Cyprus, Bangladesh, Brazil and Sri Lanka. Prior to moving to Chestertown, Maryland in 1986, Lyell lived for many years in Washington D.C.

Mr. Ritchie is survived by his wife, Alice; one sister, Elizabeth Topper of New Jersey; two sons, Lyell Kirk Ritchie of New Jersey and Alexander George Ritchie of Virginia; one daughter, Col. Elspeth Cameron Ritchie of Maryland; one stepson, Warren Clark III of Massachusetts; two stepdaughters, Sarah C. Stuart of Pennsylvania and Hope E. Clark of Maryland; five grandchildren and five step grandchildren.
