



Lyle N. Stutzman

October 8, 1947 - January 15, 2015

Lyle Neal Stutzman died around family on January 15, 2015. He was 67.

He was born on October 8, 1947, to the late Lyle A. and Lee Ella (Johnston) Stutzman in Chambersburg, PA. Lyle was a graduate of Brooklyn Park High School in Baltimore after spending his childhood in New Bedford, MA.

Following his undergraduate studies at Anne Arundel Community College and Towson State University, he served the State of Maryland as a Correctional Officer in Jessup, MD. Lyle's love of nature and the outdoors led his family to move from Pasadena to Grasonville in 1986.

As a devoted father and husband, Lyle loved to take part in activities that brought his family closer together. He especially enjoyed spending time outdoors, and relished the opportunity to travel. As the son of a WWII veteran, he had a deep appreciation for those who served our country. He was a member of the Sons of Veterans American Legion and VFW in Grasonville, and was a lifetime member of the Bay Country Moose Lodge in Queenstown.

He is survived by his wife of 44 years, Marlene Stutzman, of Grasonville; son, Jason Stutzman of Grasonville; daughter, Laura Stutzman Sines and her husband Shawn Sines of South Carolina; uncle Andrew Dembeck; sisters Jean Martin and Lisa Petty, and brother John Stutzman. In addition to his parents, Lyle was predeceased by his son, Matthew Neal Stutzman in 1981.

A visitation will be held on Tuesday, January 20, 2015, from 6-8 PM, at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A. in Chester, MD. Services will be held at 11 AM on Wednesday, January 21, 2015, at the funeral home, and will be followed by interment at Meadowridge Memorial Park in Elkridge, MD.
