Stevensville – Lyle Edward Grupenhoff of Stevensville, formerly of South Towson, died on Wednesday, May 30, 2001 at John's Hopkins University. He was 61.

Born on August 2, 1939 in Ohio, he was the son of the late Edna Sullivan and Edwin Grupenhoff.
