



## Lyman Neal Moore

April 23, 1951 - April 3, 2014

Lyman Neal Moore passed away on April 3, 2014, at his home in Stevensville, MD, surrounded by his loving family. He was 62.

Born on April 23, 1951, in Bethesda, MD, he is preceded in death by his parents Lyman and Cynthia (Hawley) Moore. Neal married Veronia (Buttner) Moore on June 6, 1985.

He worked as a boat mechanic for seven years at Castle Marina. He worked as an upholsterer early in his career, specializing in interior restoration and glass. Later, he obtained his CDL and became a heavy equipment operator for Ferguson Trenching Company, Inc.
