



Lyman E. Clark

Lyman E. "Nick" Clark of Royal Oak, MD, formerly of Oak Island, NC, died on Tuesday, October 22, 2002 at Talbot Hospice House, Easton, MD. He was 82.

Born February 6, 1920 in Chester, MA, he was the son of the late Jesse P. and Agnes Cross Clark. He was a 1938 graduate of Western High School in Washington, D.C. In 1942 he enlisted in the United States Coast Guard as an Aviation Machinist. After his honorable discharge from active duty in 1946, he entered George Washington University where, in 1950, he earned his Bachelor of Civil Engineering degree. An employee of the U.S. Veterans Administration in Washington, D.C., he worked as a Civil and Fire Protection Engineer. After his retirement in 1976, Mr. Clark and his wife, the former Virginia C. O'Shaughnessy, retired to Oak Island, NC. In 1993 he moved to Royal Oak, MD.

Mrs. Clark died February 26, 1987.

A lifelong Red Sox fan, he enjoyed coaching and umpiring local Little League and high school sports. He enjoyed playing golf and loved all athletics.

Mr. Clark is survived by a daughter, Ruthie McGuire and her husband, Mark of Royal Oak, MD; a son, Andrew Clark and his wife, Jane of Tiburn, CA; three grandchildren, Virginia Kate, Kelly Marie and Matthew Thomas, all of Royal

Oak; two sisters, Grace Tyler of Connecticut and Jesse Mills of Virginia and a nephew, H. Thomas Moore of Ellicott City, MD. Four brothers, Lewis, Frank, Fred and Charles Clark and one sister, Lillian Butman are deceased.

A memorial service will be held on Friday, October 25, 2002 at 4:00 PM at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A., Easton, MD.

Interment will be at St. Philips By the Sea Memorial Garden, South Port, NC at a later date.
