July 15, 1949 - December 11, 2014

Lynda Helena Squibb of Millington, MD, devoted wife, mother, and friend, died at her home on Thursday, December 11, 2014. She was 65.

Lynda H. Squibb was born July 15, 1949, in Luton, England, the daughter of the late Aubrey Albert Hensbrey and Florence Ivy "Sawyer" Hensbrey. Lynda grew up and spent her first 21 years in England. On October 3, 1970, she married Ralph Squibb in Leagrave, England. Due to her husband's military career, they spent a lot of time moving around. In 1973, they moved to Alexandria, VA; in 1978, they moved to Germany; in 1981, they moved back to Alexandria, VA; moved again in 1985 to the Waldorf, MD; and in 2007, the two moved to Millington.

Lynda was certified as a dental assistant and dental x-ray technician through Charles County Community College and worked in the field for many years. She most recently worked for Kent County Department of Social Services where she did data entry for almost five years before being diagnosed with cancer. Lynda loved spending time with her family, knitting, reading, and tatting.

Lynda is survived by her husband, Ralph Squibb, Jr., of Millington, MD; one son, Jason Lee Squibb of Millington, MD; one daughter, Rebecca Ann Rice of Millington, MD; one sister, Beryl Duffy of England; and three grandchildren.

A visitation will be held Wednesday, December 17, 2014, from 6 to 7 p.m. at Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, 370 Cypress St., Millington, MD. Services will begin at 7 p.m. also at the funeral home.

Interment will be private.

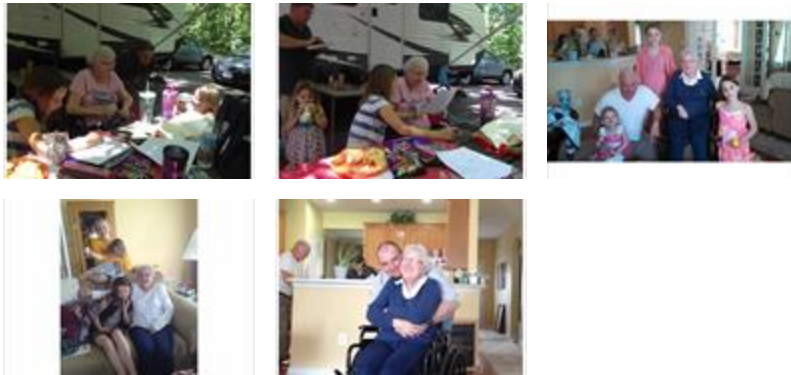
