



## Lynne H. Rich

June 14, 1941 - December 20, 2010

Easton – Lynne Henderson Rich died Monday, Dec. 20, 2010 at the Memorial Hospital at Easton of cancer and related causes.

She was born in Wilmington, NC on June 14, 1941. She was the wife of Warren K. Rich and the mother of three sons: Edward Thompson, Jr., Davis Thompson, and Marshall Thompson. She was the step-mother of a daughter, Amy Rung, and three sons: Peter Rich, Matthew Rich, and Christopher Rich; and the grandmother of 11 grandchildren.

Lynne was educated at the University of North Carolina – Greensboro and the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. She was a member of the Talbot Country Club and Bel Air Country Club in Clearwater, FL. She was the owner of Cross Court Athletic Club in Easton. Her permanent residence was in Easton.

Lynne was the initial fundraiser and one of the founders of Habitat for Humanity in Talbot County. She was the founder of the Follies in Talbot, in which she performed and raised funds for Habitat. She was also on the Board of Directors of CASA of Talbot County and the Talbot Historical Society. She participated in numerous sports with great competence including tennis, golf and downhill skiing. Recently, her favorite pastime was walking the beaches in and around Clearwater, FL with her close friend. She was part of a worship

group called the Cuppers, which was affiliated with the Christ Church in Easton.

There will be a memorial service at 11:00 am on Thursday, Dec. 23 at Christ Church, 111 South Harrison St. in Easton.
