Madeline Elburn Howell of Worton, MD died on Tuesday, February 3, 2004 at the Chester River Hospital Center in Chestertown, MD. She was 66.

Born on June 5, 1937 in Piney Neck, Rock Hall, MD, she was the daughter of the late, George Cleveland and Ellen Madeline Cannon Elburn.
