Madeline S. Jackson of Easton, MD, died on Tuesday, June 17, 2014, at Mandrin Inpatient Care Center in Harwood. She was 88. Born in Oxford on July 13, 1925, she was born to the late Emory and Ivy Twigg Sullivan.
