



## Madeline "Maddy" Stella Giordano

February 28, 1920 - July 27, 2015

Madeline "Maddy" Stella Giordano (nee Iannacchione), of Chestertown, MD, passed away at the age of 95 on July 27, 2015, at Autumn Lake Healthcare at Chestertown. Formerly, she was a resident of Chestnut Hill, PA, and Ventnor, New Jersey.

Born on February 28, 1920, in Philadelphia, PA, she was the daughter of the late Oreste Iannacchione and Maria Grazia Tribuiani. Maddy graduated from The Philadelphia High School for Girls in 1939. She served with the Women's Army Corps during World War II along with her sister, the late Mary Cella, while her brothers (Thomas and the late Joseph Ianna) were serving in the Army.

In 1944, she married James C. Giordano. Together they owned and operated several businesses, including Devonair Cut Rate and Giordano's Surgical Supply in Chestnut Hill, PA. She was an active member of the community and of Our Mother of Consolation parish in Chestnut Hill.

Maddy was an avid traveler and enjoyed visiting new places with her friends and family. She spent many years at the Jersey Shore, going to the beach, strolling the boards, trying her luck at the casinos and seeing shows. Her hobbies included making intricate puzzles and fiber arts. Her needlepoint work received several awards.

She is survived by her sons, James Giordano and wife Carol of Chestertown, MD, and Francis Giordano and wife Nancy of North Attleboro, MA, as well as numerous grandchildren and great-grandchildren, and her brother, Thomas Ianna.

Maddy will deeply be missed by her family and friends; however, they know that she is now at peace and has a place in Heaven as an angel looking out for all.

Services will be held on August 4, 2015, at 10 a.m. at Our Mother of Consolation Church in Chestnut Hill, PA. Interment will follow at Holy Sepulchre Cemetery in Philadelphia.

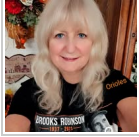
