Madelin Mae (Knaupp) Bowen Harbert of Frederick, MD, formerly of Laurel, MD passed away on Sunday, November 23, 2008 at Homewood at Crumland Farms in Frederick, MD at the age of 98. She was born on May 25, 1910 in Troy, New York to the late John Frederick and Henrietta Louisa (Salisbury) Knaupp.
