



Madlyn "Madge" Ewing Wooters

September 10, 1930 - August 31, 2024

Madlyn "Madge" Ewing Wooters, 93, of Queenstown, MD, died at Compass Hospice in Centreville, MD on August 31, 2024 from complications from dementia.

Madge was born in Easton, MD, on September 10, 1930 to Marie V. Tyler and Francis Adams Ewing. She grew up on the family farm in Easton with ten siblings Francis, Alton, Paul, Bessie, Bunny, Bobby, Jim, Gene, David and Susie. Her favorite sport was basketball, which she got to practice daily before school by catching a ride on the morning milk wagon at 6 am as it passed the farm.

After graduation, she married William E. Wooters on December 3, 1950. She served as the Register of Wills for Queens Anne's County for 18 years, retiring in 1986. Madge was a Member of the Register of Wills Association, an Executive on the Democratic Women's Club of Queen Anne's County, a member of the Memorial Hospital Association, the Queen Anne's County Historical Society and a parishioner and member of the Alter & Rosary Society and choir of St. Peter's Catholic Church in Queenstown. She was also a member of the Daughters of Revolution.

Madge, "Nana", is survived by her four sons, Don (Clay), Billy (Mary Ann), Craig (Lucretia), and Mark (Kelley), and seven grandchildren: Melissa (Dave),

Brian (Amanda), Danielle, Michael, Sarah, Kasen, and Wren. Three great-children also survive her: Maddox, Paisley, and Delaney.

A graveside service will be held on Thursday, 5 September, at 1:30pm, at St. Peter the Apostle Church in Queenstown (5319 Ocean Gateway, Queenstown).
