



## Major John Hackett Anderson

A Funeral Liturgy for Major John Hackett Anderson, U.S. Air Force ret. will be celebrated at Sts. Peter & Paul Catholic Church, Easton on Tuesday, July 25, 2006 at 11:00 AM. Major Anderson died at his home on Tuesday, July 18, 2006. He was 82.

Born in Talbot County, May 7, 1924, he was the son of the late John and Agnes Othelia Skinner Anderson. After graduating from Cordova High School in 1941, he entered the University of Maryland where he was a member of the Reserve Officers Training Corps. Called to active duty in 1943, he served in the U.S. Army Air Corps until his release from active duty in 1945. In 1952, he earned a Bachelor of Science degree in marketing and economics from the University of Maryland and then joined the U.S. Air Force. During his military career he served at bases in the U.S., Japan and Spain before retiring in 1969 with the rank of Major. Following his retirement, he lived in Easton until 1989 at which time he moved to Dover, DE and then back to Easton in 1994.

A member of Sts. Peter & Paul Catholic Church, Easton, he was also a former member of Talbot Post #70 American Legion, Easton, a member of Fox Post #2 American Legion, Dover, DE and E. E. Streets Memorial Post #5118 V.F.W., Easton. He had also been very active in the Civil Air Patrol in Talbot County.

Major Anderson is survived by his wife, the former Virginia Eastham Payne, whom he married in Easton on January 15, 1949; a son, John Michael Anderson of Charlotte, NC; two daughters, Donna Marie Messick of Easton and Patricia Ann Mitchell of Salisbury; a sister, Marie H. Anderson of Easton; and four grandchildren.
