Subsequently, she came to Baltimore on the famous transfer of English wives on the Queen Mary. Spent the rest of her life in Baltimore area, raising adopted son and later briefly worked for Silbers Bakery. Her husband died on Christmas day in England on his first vacation in 20 years. As a widow, she moved to Towson and eventually spent all but her last 3 years at Hampton Plaza, also serving as their primary night receptionist.

Beloved of all that knew her, she loved all her friends there and enjoyed her time there greatly. Upon incurring kidney failure in 2008, she moved with her son where she spent the last few years on the Eastern Shore.

She is survived by her loving son, Doug, daughter-in-law Alison; her 3 adoring grandchildren, Bree, Whitney and Tyler. 2 sisters and a brother living in England.
