Manuel Carrion Martinez of Cordova died on Monday, March 20, 2000 at the University of Maryland Medical Center in Baltimore. He was 48.

Born in Caguas, Puerto Rico on July 15, 1951, he was the son of Dolores Martinez Galarza and Manuel Carrion Velez. At age seventeen he moved to the continental U.S. and eventually settled in Trappe. He worked for the Trappe Packing Company for about ten years before going to work for the Charwill Cannery in Trappe in 1971. In 1982, he moved to Cordova. Due to illness, he retired in 1999.

Mr. Martinez is survived by his wife, the former Deborah Lee Morris of Cordova; a son, Manuel Martinez Camper of Centreville; a step-son, Ronald Meredith, Jr. of Preston; a step-daughter, JoAnn Ewing of Greensboro, one grandchild and three step-grandchildren.
