Marcia Gail Minissale of Galena, MD died Monday, September 27, 2010 at Elkton Care and Rehab in Elkton, MD. She was 68.

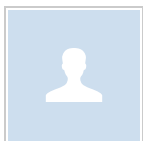

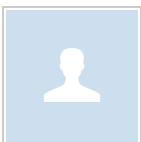
