The Honorable M. Hallsted Christ, 86, of Trappe, MD died peacefully on Sunday, November 12, 2017 at the Talbot Hospice House.

He was born in New Hyde Park, New York on December 19, 1930, son of the late Hon. Marcus G. Christ and Marion Hallsted.

Judge Christ grew up on Long Island, New York along with his brothers Philip and Donald and his sister Charlotte. He was educated at the Choate school, moving on to obtain a B.A. degree from Colgate University and a law degree from New York University. He had a distinguished legal career as a named partner at his law firm in Minneola, NY. He served as president of the Nassau County Bar Association, was elected and served on the Board of the Town of Oyster Bay and was elected and served as Comptroller of Nassau County, New York. In 1982 he was sworn in to the position of Judge on the New York State Supreme Court, where he served until his retirement in 1992.

Upon his retirement, he and his wife, the late Ann Gilbert, moved to their farm in Trappe, MD. In Trappe, he fully embraced his new life as a farmer, avid fisherman, hunter and yachtsman. In between planting, harvest and waterfowl seasons, he and Ann sailed their Grand Banks yacht throughout the east coast of the United States from the Bahamas to Canada, the Great Lakes and the Mississippi. He was an active member of the Tred Avon and Chesapeake Yacht Clubs as well as the local Romeo's organization.

Judge Christ is survived by his four children, Marcus, Geraldine, John and

Marion, as well as eight grandchildren
