Marcus Raymond Gottlieb, Sr. of Tilghman died on Monday, July 30, 2001 at the Memorial Hospital, Easton. He was 74.

Born in Baltimore on June 15, 1927, he was the son of the late John and Mary Oppel Gottlieb. He attended school in Baltimore and went to work as a foreman at National Plastics until 1966 when he moved to Tilghman. Once in Tilghman, he worked as a fisherman for Hedge Fairbanks until 1976 when he became the boat captain for the "Marie M". He ran fishing parties on the "Marie M" until he was forced to retire in 1983 due to bad health.

Mr. Gottlieb was a former member of the St. Clemens Catholic Church in Landsdown. He was also a member of the Loyal Order of the Moose, Lodge #1520.

In addition to his wife, the former June Catherine Evans, whom he married on April 26, 1952, he is survived by four daughters, Linda Pinder of Panama City, FL, Arlene Smith of Baltimore, Cathy Schaake of Hillsboro, and Connie Plutschak of Easton; a son, Mark Gottlieb of Tilghman; a sister, Margaret Roman; three brothers, Vernon Gottlieb, Elwood Gottlieb, and Charles Gottlieb; 14 grandchildren and 11 great-grandchildren. A sister, Frances Hood, and four brothers, John Gottlieb, George Gottlieb, Frank Gottlieb, and Edward Gottlieb, are deceased.
