



## Margaret E. George

June 7, 1936 - July 20, 2018

Margaret E. George of Queen Anne, MD, died on July 20, 2018, at the UMSMC at Easton. She was 82.

Born in Marion, IA, on June 7, 1936, she was the daughter of the late Adam and Elizabeth Dishington Reid. She married Ernest E. George on January 14, 1956, and the couple made their home first in Wye Mills before moving to Queen Anne, MD.
