Margaret (Dolly) Virginia McNulty was born October 10, 1927, in Ridley Park, PA. She was the daughter of the late John Wallace McNulty and Margaret Evans McNulty.

Dolly's twilight years were spent enjoying her many hobbies, her rescue cats, and the place she loved most of all, Blooming Neck Farm.
