Margaret "Peggy" Marion Hoagland of Venice, FL, died on July 10, 2014, at Chester River Manor in Chestertown, MD. She was 90.

Peggy was born on July 6, 1924, in Quincy, MA. She was the daughter of the late Dr. Paul H. and Edith Laura Whitford Karcher. She attended Thayer Academy and then graduated from North Quincy High School in Massachusetts. In her college years, she graduated Phi Theta Kappa 45', 46' at Endicott Junior College in Beverly, MA. She also attended Wheaton College, studying Pre Med.

Every summer as a child, Peggy enjoyed her family's home in Cape Cod, where she learned to sail and play tennis. She started horseback riding at a very early age and competed at Madison Square Garden. Her love for horses continued her entire life and to this day, there is still a horse in the barn. Peggy had trained in opera and ballet in her younger years and was approached by many top model agencies and movie producers.

On October 3, 1947, she married Everett John Hoagland, who predeceased her in 2012. They had shared a fabulous life together for 65 years. They traveled the world and enjoyed a tremendous amount of love and laughter. They loved all of their children, animals, and friends unconditionally and enjoyed their years on the farm.

In her youth, she belonged with her family to the Quincy Country Club and a member of the Bass River Yacht Club in Cape Cod, Massachusetts. She in her late husband, John, have been members of Huntingdon Valley Country Club for over 55 years in Pennsylvania and as a resident of Florida, they belonged to Jacaranda West Country Club. While visiting with her children in Kent County, she attended the Covenant Baptist Church in Chestertown, MD.

She is survived by her daughter, Debra Hoagland of Chestertown, MD; three sons, Steven J. Hoagland and wife Belinda of Douglasville, PA, Robert P. Hoagland of Fort Washington , PA, and Roy P. Hoagland of Chestertown, MD. She was predeceased by a brother, Earl Karcher.
