



## Margaret Bolliger Johnson

March 7, 1922 - January 21, 2013

Margaret Bolliger Johnson died January 21, 2013, at Heron Point, Chestertown, MD, at the age of 90. She battled health issues related to multiple strokes and progressive dementia with grace, courage, and kindness.

Margaret adopted the nickname Meg in 1979 when her husband Dwight Howard (Bud) Johnson retired from the DuPont company, and they moved to Chestertown. Meg and Bud spent as much time as they could sailing the Chester River, Chesapeake Bay, and Eastern seaboard together on their sloop Edelweiss and then ketch Serenity until Bud died in 1994.

Meg was always a sports enthusiast, and enjoyed playing golf with her husband and friends as well as playing tennis, swimming, diving, skiing (downhill and cross-country), and hiking. In 2004, she moved to Heron Point. Even after her health declined to the point where she could no longer participate in sports, she continued to walk regularly, with friends or on her own, to enjoy being out in the fresh air. She was very proud of her Swiss heritage and remained a huge fan of Swiss chocolates her entire life. Meg also loved to paint and was active in the Chestertown Art League.

Meg was born on March 7, 1922, in Brooklyn, NY, to Margarethe Eckerlin Wullschleger and Rudolf Bolliger, who came to New York from Switzerland shortly after marrying. She graduated from Erasmus High School in Brooklyn,

NY, and subsequently married her high school sweetheart, Bud Johnson in 1943. During the early years of their marriage, they lived in Brooklyn and San Diego, CA, while Bud served in the Navy during World War II. After Bud completed his education, Meg, Bud, and their two children moved to Wilmington, DE. The family spent two years in Orange, TX, then moved to Kennett Square, PA, where they stayed until Bud retired in 1979.

Meg is survived by her two children, Karen Urioste of Port Townsend, WA, and Glenn Johnson and his wife Patricia of Hanover, NH; her grandchildren, Alexander (Catherine) Urioste of San Diego, CA, Mark (Heidi) Urioste of Santa Rosa, CA, Bryan (Janelle) Urioste of San Antonio, TX, and Ward (Amy) Johnson of Colchester, VT; and her seven great-grandchildren, Nathan and Ryan Urioste, Oscar and Adelaide Urioste, and Griffin, Coen, and Saylor Urioste. She is also survived by her dear and devoted friend, Jackie Miller of Easton, Maryland.
