



## Ms. Margaret Estelle McAuliffe

August 30, 1920 - March 27, 2013

Margaret Estelle McAuliffe (nee Beaver), 92, of Taylorsville, formerly of Kent County and Howard County, died at home from complications of dementia.

Born August 30, 1920, she was the daughter of the late Jesse O. Beaver and Ethel (Cooper) Beaver Chaires. She was the wife of Thomas J. McAuliffe, who died in 1980.
