The family of Margaret Mullikin Moyer of The Villages, Florida, is saddened to announce her unexpected passing on December 23, 2023. She was 76 years old.

“Peggy” was born in Centreville, Maryland on October 19, 1947, to the late Joseph Cook Mullikin and Mary Tucker Lusby Mullikin. A graduate from Centreville High School and Goldey-Beacom College, Peggy worked in accounting and project management in Baltimore and Houston before retiring in Tiburon, CA in 1990.

In 2006, she spent time at MD Anderson Cancer Center supporting her late husband through his treatments. During this time, Peggy was deeply impacted by the many children receiving treatment; thus, making substantial donations to support their lifesaving care and research. This was a cause that was always very near and dear to her heart. She also volunteered as a North Carolina Guardian ad Litem, providing a voice for abused and neglected children, and advocating for their best interests in court.

Peggy was always up for an adventure and traveling was at the top of her list. She explored many countries and cultures while traveling across the globe with her late husband. Moving to new cities throughout the country was never daunting for her – more just like an exciting adventure! She loved to decorate

and always looked forward to her family and friends visiting her homes, wherever she ended up. From the San Francisco Bay area to the mountains of Asheville, Peggy was full of energy and made friends wherever she went.

Anyone who knew her knew that her children and grandchildren always came first. Peggy planned annual, family beach trips every single summer – always ocean or lakefront because she loved a good view! From weddings to holidays, to graduations and sporting events – she was always there to cheer for and support her family. Her contagious laugh and upbeat, positive outlook will be deeply missed.

Peggy is survived by her son, Kevin Hall and his wife (Annette) of Houston, TX; daughter, Kelly Martin and her husband (Brad) of Waxhaw, NC; four grandchildren (Ryan, Lauren, Colby and Cooper); brother, Joseph A. Mullikin and his wife (Linda) of Centreville, MD; and her sister, Mary Tucker Hauck of Smyrna, DE. She was predeceased by her beloved husband, Donald Moyer, and her parents, Joseph and Mary Tucker Mullikin.
