Margaret Botdorf Nesspor of Rock Hall, MD died Wednesday, September 3, 2008 at University of Maryland Medical Center in Baltimore, MD. She was 74.

She was born August 1, 1934 in Harrisonburg, PA the daughter of the late, Warren Edwin and Margaret Tudor Botdorf. Mrs. Nesspor worked as a registered nurse at Phoenixville Hospital, in Phoenixville, PA. She then went on to work as the RN charge nurse at Kent and Queen Anne's Hospital on the Medical floor.
