Margaret “Peggy” McComas Owens passed away on August 5, 2015, at The Pines in Easton, MD. She was 71.

Born in Abingdon, MD, on May 14, 1944, she was the daughter of the late Frederick Eugene McComas and Margaret Stroh McComas. She graduated from Edgewood High School, Class of 1962, and then received a B.S. degree from the University of Maryland and later her Masters Degree from Loyola University.

Mrs. Owens worked in public safety at the State of Maryland. She was active in the Queen Anne’s County Arts Council and sang with Queen Anne’s County Chorale. She performed as an actor with Theaters In The Round, Church Hill Theater, and the Pasadena Theater Company.
