Margaret T. Glenn Smith of Chestertown, MD, died on September 2, 2011, at Chester River Hospital Center in Chestertown. She was 84.

She was born in Pennsylvania on September 17, 1927, the daughter of the late John Joseph and Margaret Theresa Feeley Glenn.

Mrs. Smith graduated from John W. Hallahan High School in Philadelphia and, on November 27, 1958, she married Thomas A. Smith. He predeceased her in April of 2004.

She worked with the Carpenters Union in Philadelphia as a secretary for over 20 years before retiring. She and her husband moved to Broadneck, and Chestertown in 1997. She enjoyed sailing with her husband and spending time with her many friends in Chestertown and at Great Oak.

Mrs. Smith is survived by her two sisters, Mary Lawson and Catherine Callahan, both of Philadelphia, PA, along with numerous nieces and nephews.

A Mass of Christian Burial will be held on Saturday, September 10, 2011, at 11 a.m. at Sacred Heart Catholic Church on High Street in Chestertown.
