January 3, 1949 - June 4, 2023

Margaret “Peggy” Louise Scarbro of Millington, MD, passed away at her home on Sunday, June 4, 2023. She was 74.

Peggy was born January 3, 1949, in Washington, PA, the daughter of the late Louis R. Garrone and Delores J. Garrone. She was a 1966 graduate of Trinity High School in Washington, PA. Peggy went to work for RCA for a few years before going to cosmetology school. She worked as a beautician in PA for several years before attending electronics school and moving to Delaware in 1984 where she worked for WL Gore.

In 1993, she married the love of her life, her late husband, Roy Scarbro, and in the same year moved to Millington and started her career at Lamotte Chemical. While working at Lamotte, she received her Bachelor's of Science degree from Kennedy Western University. Peggy retired from LaMotte in 2014.

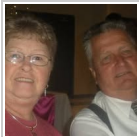
