Margaret Lee Groeninger Schatz, 79, died on October 25, 2016, at Bayleigh Chase in Easton, MD.

Margaret was born on June 22, 1937, the daughter of the late Margaret Tall Groeninger and Leo Groeninger. She grew up in Baltimore, MD, where she graduated from Cathedral Grade School, Notre Dame of Maryland Preparatory School, and St. Joseph College in Emmitsburg, MD. In 1979, she earned a Master's Degree in Clinical Social Work from University of MD. In 1960, she married Donald Schatz.

Margaret Lee Schatz worked as a Clinical Social Worker at Maryland Training School for Boys and at Johns Hopkins University Counseling and Psychiatric Services for Students. Following these years, she went into private practice and retired in Easton.

In addition to her husband of 56 years, Don, she is survived by her two children, Robert Thomas Schatz and Susan Caulfield Schatz Wise; a brother, Robert Groeninger; and two grandchildren, Christopher and Andrew Wise. She was preceded in death by a third child, Mark Gerard Schatz, who died at birth. She was also preceded in death by a brother, Gerard Groeninger.
