Margaret “Peggy” Stubbs of Queenstown, MD died at her home on Saturday, February 28, 2004. She was 78.

Peggy was born in Queenstown, MD on December 18, 1925 to the late Bishop Lister and Mary Smith Lister. After graduating from Centreville High School, she began working for Friel Cannery and later Dr. Hitch’s Drug Store in Queenstown. On January 14, 1946 she married Earl Stubbs of Church Hill, MD and made their home on Kent Island. Peggy then began working for Framptons Grocery Store in Stevensville, MD as a sales clerk. In 1964 she started working for the William Preston Lane, Jr. Memorial Bridge (Chesapeake Bay Bridge). In May of 1985 she retired from the Chesapeake Bay Bridge as a Toll Sergeant. On April 18, 1998 her husband, Earl, of 58 years of marriage, predeceased her.

Peggy enjoyed reading, playing bingo, listening to Fats Domino, and watching old movies (Gone with the wind being her favorite)and she was an avid Yankee fan. She was a member of the Kent Island American Legion Post #278 Ladies Auxiliary.

Peggy is survived by three children, Barbara Ream and husband Bobby of Queenstown, MD, Johnny Stubbs of Queenstown, MD and Peggy Lewis and husband Brent of Grasonville, MD; two brothers, Robert “Bobby” Lister of

Queenstown, MD and Charles Lister of Centreville, MD; two grandchildren, Nancy Austin of Grasonville, MD, Ryan Stubbs of Queenstown, MD; one step grandchild, Nicole Bosley Lewis of Montana; and one great grandchild, Logan Rogers of Centreville, MD.
