Margaret C. Davis of Chestertown, MD, died Friday, January 11, 2008 at Heron Point in Chestertown, MD. She was 87.

Born November 16, 1920 in Baltimore, MD, she was the daughter of the late, Algernon Houston Chandler and Susan Tyler Chandler. Mrs. Davis attended Girls Latin school and then went on to St. Mary's Female Seminary where she graduated in 1939. Mrs. Davis was an avid golfer with claims to two holes in one on the same hole at Elkridge Country Club. Mrs. Davis worked as a volunteer for the Red Cross during World War II as a supply truck driver where she drove supplies between Washington and Baltimore. She also volunteered at the Children's Hospital in Baltimore and later in life at the Chester River Hospital Center. She opened the gift shop and served as its first manager at Heron Point.

Mrs. Davis was a board member of Nottingham Properties from 1959- 1993, she was a board member of the Boy's Home Society, a member of the Chesapeake Center of Youth Development in Baltimore, member of the Chester River Association and past president of the Women's Golf Association in Baltimore.

In addition to her parents, Mrs. Davis was preceded in death by her three husbands, Richard L. Campbell, N. Page Worthington and Richard G. Davis;

one son, Chip Campbell and one sister, Matilda Wilkins.

Mrs. Davis is survived by two sons, Chuck Campbell of Black Mountain, NC and Tyler Campbell of Chestertown, MD; eight grandchildren, eight great grandchildren and two nephews, Bob Denison of Chestertown, MD and Bill Denison of Towson, MD.
